## Political Science Scholarships

The following scholarships are intended for students studying political science. However, another great source of political science scholarships is any political groups you are affiliated with, so be sure to check with your membership organizations for additional opportunities.

### **Dr. Aura-Lee A. and James Hobbs Pittenger American History Scholarship**

The Dr. Aura-Lee A. and James Hobbs Pittenger American History Scholarship is awarded to graduating high school students who will pursue an undergraduate degree with a concentrated study of a minimum of 24 credit hours in American History and American Government. Renewal is conditional upon maintenance of a GPA of 3.25. This scholarship is renewable. This award is intended to promote the study of our country's history among our finest students. U.S. Citizens residing abroad may apply through a Units Overseas Chapter.

The Dr. Aura-Lee A. and James Hobbs Pittenger American History Scholarship is an award of \$2,000 each year for up to four years with annual transcript review by the National Chairman required for renewal.

### **National Washington Crossing Foundation Scholarship Awards**

During the years since the work of the Foundation began, we have remained steadfast in our purpose and have seen a resurgence of interest in acquiring accurate and inspiring information about historical figures. The principal beneficiaries of the Foundation's programs are the nation's schoolchildren. - Entrants receiving full four-year tuition scholarships shall only be eligible for one-year special awards.

In 2006, the Board of Directors of the Energy Telecommunications & Electrical Association (ENTELEC; [www.entelec.org](http://www.entelec.org)) established the Wayne V. Black Scholarship Award. It was with great sadness that in the fall of 2011, ENTELEC mourned the loss of Mr. Black. The scholarship has been renamed the “Wayne V. Black Memorial Scholarship Award”.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- To be eligible for consideration, the Applicant must be a currently enrolled full time undergraduate student in good academic standing at an accredited college or university in the United States or Canada.
- The Applicant must be working towards a Bachelor’s degree in one of the following curricula:
  - Engineering/ Engineering Technology
  - Computer Science/MIS
  - Pre-law
  - Political Science
  - Telecommunications/Information Technology
- The Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or Permanent Resident or Canadian citizen.
- Family members of active members of the ENTELEC Board of Directors are not eligible to apply.
